1. Livy called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

2. Public comment: No public comment

3. Review of minutes

- A. Mowing bids:

- B. Mud Season signs: Livy and Donna have started to place signs temporarily limiting parking. Chris will add surveyors tape temporarily blocking off parking on the grass
- C. Port-o-lets will be ordered for April
- D. Covered bridge update: Bruce had no news to report. As we think about funding, Donna suggests that we separate the abutment work from the walls/roof rebuild.
- E. Trails grant: We made the first cut but now must submit the full application to renovate Field Stone West Loop. State reimbursement for these types of projects has been reduced to \$30,000.
- F. ARPA update: Chris and Donna updated the board on the ARPA presentation to the select boards. They have started the formal documents and a presentation intended for the Selectboard meeting
- G. Spring trail work day is tentatively set for May 7 (Green Up Day)
